FESTIVAL OF COMBUSTION FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

Is parking available at the Carrie Furnaces? Yes free parking is available and limited VIP parking is available for an added fee. If you purchase VIP parking online when buying your advance tickets, you will be guaranteed a parking space inside the site gates. General parking is available on a first-come-first-serve basis on the western portion of the site.

Where is the VIP Parking? VIP Parking is located in the western courtyard, inside the fenceline, Please look for VIP Parking sign on the fenceline after you enter the site.

Is food available at the Festival of Combustion - Yes food trucks will be on site all day and evening provided by <u>Rogue BBQ</u> food truck, Taqueria El Pastorcito taco truck as well as snow cones.

Are there restrooms available? Yes porta-potty style restrooms are available throughout the entire event.

Is free water available at the Festival of Combustion? Yes free water is available at select locations courtesy of Rivers of Steel.

Can we bring blankets and chairs? Yes feel free to bring blankets and bag chairs for the evening concert and fireworks display. Grassy space is available.

Do I need boots to visit the Carrie Furnaces? No but closed toed shoes are strongly recommended. The site is still a former industrial mill and not appropriate for sandals or high heels etc.

When are the hands on workshops offered? Hands-on workshops are only offered during the daytime portion of the event from 1-6pm.

Are workshops free during the Festival of Combustion? Yes! All workshops are free but numbers are limited so arrive early and stay late for the performances and fireworks! For a full list of workshops visit:
